WHAT: Community Yard Sale (yard sellers/resellers only-PRICE TO SELL. Items NOT permitted to sell include, but are not limited to boutique, livestock, animals, firearms, obscene material, alcohol, drugs, food, drink, illegal substances, etc.)

PURPOSE: This Community Yard Sale is an event to raise funds for the local Community Center with the distinction that this is NOT for the City of Andersonville, but for the Sheppard-Pride Community Center.

Our primary objectives are to:

- 1-raise funds for the local community center to be able to continue to better serve residents like YOU!
- 2-bring the community together.
- 3-have fun!

DATE: Saturday, September 6, 2025 (In case of rain, Yard Sale will be delayed to Saturday, September 27, 2025)

SALE HOURS: 8am -12pm

Sellers may begin setting up at 7am and must be packed up by 12:45pm, but no later than 1pm. SPCC Representatives will be on-site starting at 7:30am and leaving the site at 1pm (please be mindful and considerate of their time.)

ALL yard sellers and vendors are responsible for their own areas including items, funds, cleanliness, children, and behavior.

WHERE: Turner Field- next to the Andersonville Fire Station and Tennis Court located at 106 N. Oglethorpe Street, Andersonville, GA.

YARD SELLER FEE: \$10 Flat Rate per 10'x10' site (Must provide your own set-up including tents, tables, chairs, etc. unless other arrangements have been made with the SPCC Representatives)

*Add-on options available on a first come first served (FCFS) while supplies last, quantities limited:

Black foldable table 2.5ft x 8 ft- rent at \$10 each

Black foldable chairs- rent at \$2 each

Grocery bags (gently used)- purchase at 10/\$1

Bottles of Water- purchase at \$0.50 each through SPCC Table

50/50 Raffle- purchase at \$1/ticket from SPCC Representative-Must include first and last name and contact information.

Drawing will be held at 11:30 AM. You do NOT have to be present to win. If not present, winner will be contacted to make arrangements to pick up prize. Winner must show proof of identification with matching first and last name on winning ticket upon collecting prize and agree to have photo taken. If prize is not collected within one week from drawing, funds will be added to the SPCC account. Must be 18+ to pick up prize.

REGISTRATION: Required. Deadline is Wednesday, September 3, 2025. (In case of rain, delay to Wednesday, September 24, 2025)

Completed forms may be sent via Facebook messenger, given to SPCC Volunteer, sent to point of contact via email or text, turned in at the Sheppard-Pride Community Center or the Andersonville City Office, or filled out online via the City's Website under the Community Center tab or by using either of the following:

Funds are non-refundable. When funds are sent/collected, the SPCC Representatives will accept this as securing your spot as a Yard Seller and you will be notified asap, but no later than Friday, September 5, 2025, if your reservation has been accepted/declined. If you have not received communication/verification that your reservation has been accepted/declined, please contact us for clarification. If rain-delay, funds previously paid are rolled over to new sale date, September 27, 2025.

Additional Information:

Restrooms: The firehouse will be open for restroom use. Please help maintain area.

Kiddie Area: There will be a kiddie area in the center of the field/sale for children to play. This area will be unattended, but centrally located for convenience and safety. Use Kiddie Area at own risk.

Sumter Humane Society: Sumter Humane Society will be participating in the Kiddie Area by bringing animals from the shelter for the kids and animals to play together. They will also have a booth set up for informational purposes. Ask them about their different programs including fostering, adoption, volunteering, donations, and more! They will be set up 8am-9am or longer depending on the animal's tolerance.

Café Campesino: Café Campesino will be offering coffee beverages for purchase during the event.

Mother's Love Homestead: Grit and Grace Micro Bakery: Mother's Love will be offering breakfast snacks i.e. muffins and pastries for purchase during the event. For preorders, please reach out to them directly at 229-591-4925 so that your order will be ready for pick-up.

Across the Map: Missions and Ministries: ATM has agreed to accept donations from items, except furniture, that may be left over after the yard sale has ended. NO FURNITURE ALLOWED. Please see their Facebook page for more information regarding their nonprofit organization.

City of Andersonville: The City of Andersonville, including City Councilmembers and City Workers, has agreed to help with loading and hauling donations to ATM, pre and post event needs such as set up and take down, assist SPCC Representatives during event, and allowing use of garbage dumpster before, during, and after event, and use of the Firehouse breezeway for coverage and restroom use. Please help maintain these areas.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY: I agree to indemnify, release and hold harmless the City of Andersonville, the Sheppard-Pride Community Center, and their respective officers, agents, employees and volunteers from any and all costs, liabilities, expenses, claims, compensation, demands, or causes of action on account of any loss or damage to person or property arising out of or in connection during the setting up, operation, or breaking down/packing up, sales made, or activities conducted during the community-wide yard sale. Additionally, if I am a Vendor, I agree that I have up-to-date business licensing and certifications necessary for running and operating. The City of Andersonville/SPCC reserves the right to terminate and cancel registration for any reason at any time including but not limited to a participant failing to adhere to items prohibited for sale. NO LIVESTOCK, ANIMALS, OBSCENE MATERIALS, ALCOHOL, DRUGS, FIREARMS, FOOD OR DRINKS*.

*The SPCC will be selling water for \$0.50 per bottle. There may be approved vendors permitted to sell food/drink. You may bring food/drink for your personal consumption, but not for selling purposes. This is a fundraiser for the Community Center. Agreements have been made with such approved vendors for fundraising purposes. Please assist with our efforts by adhering to these guidelines so that we may better serve you.

WAIVER OF PROPERTY, MATERIALS, AND VEHICLES: I agree to maintain, care for, and return undamaged any and all property borrowed, used, or rented for this event i.e. table, chairs, 10'x10' site, restrooms, firetruck, breezeway, etc. If left/returned broken, damaged, or in poor condition, I understand that I will be fully responsible for replacing the item(s) with equal or greater valued item(s) or funds, whichever is deemed most appropriate by SPCC Representative(s) and City of Andersonville Personnel and/or Sumter County Personnel as necessary.

Vendors and Yard Sellers may begin setting up on the day of sale prior to 8 AM and commit to refrain from packing up no earlier than 12:00 PM. ALL ITEMS MUST BE REMOVED AND SPACES CLEANED UP NO LATER THAN 1:00 PM.
